

**GREENWOOD TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES  
MINUTES OF MARCH 10, 2026**

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Supervisor Lindsey.

Board members present: Fred Lindsey, Diane Bissonette - Treasurer, Amy Lake - Clerk, Brandon Watson - Trustee. Trustee Annette Chalmers was excused.

Bissonette motioned to approve the agenda as written, second by Lake. All in favor.

Lindsey motioned to approve the minutes of the regular board meeting of February 10, 2026 and the minutes of the budget meeting of February 23, 2026, second by Watson. All in favor.

**Public Comment:**

Resident Val Richardson spoke to the number of vehicles speeding on Williams Rd. between Townline and Woodridge. She stated there is virtually no law enforcement presence and there are approximately 15 children in that area. Val has tried contacting the sheriff but has had no luck. She asked if the township could possibly have some signs installed that would alert drivers that children, including a handicapped child, are present, that the area is residential and to please slow down. The supervisor will speak with the sheriff and the road commission to offer some assistance.

**Clerk Report:**

Amy reported the disbursement of 33 checks in the amount of \$65,844.14 from the general fund. The increased amount reflects the \$45,021.16 check to the road commission for seasonal road brining. A disbursement of 21 checks in the amount of \$11,985.44 from the fire department fund. Bissonette motioned to pay the bills, second from Lake. A roll call vote was taken with Lindsey, Bissonette, Lake and Watson voting in favor.

**Treasurer Report:**

Diane reported the ending fund balance for all funds at \$357,216.66. Tax collection season through the township has ended. Any remaining taxes to be paid will need to go to the county treasurer.

Fire Chief Moll reported four calls for service for the month of February 2026. An officer and a training meeting were held. Welcome to Dan Vidolich, who just completed FF training, and is a new FD member. Congratulations, Dan!

Zoning Administrator Ron Palmquist reported two approved permits for residential structures and one permit for TMobile to add their equipment to the township cell tower.

The Planning Commission will meet on March 17,2026.

The Zoning Board of Appeals met on February 16, 2026 for election of officers. The board consists of: Tom Voyles - Chairperson, Dave Ferguson - Vice Chairperson, Martha McMahan - Recording Secretary. Michael Ralicki is a member and Carol Wylie serves as alternate.

The ZBA met on March 9, 2026 to hear a request for a dimensional variance. The request was granted.

The Assessor Report was read by Lindsey.

Commissioner Report:

Commissioner McCauley attended the County Health Department meeting, the County Library meeting, where they are working to accommodate more taxpayers by shifting their hours of operation, and the Veterans meeting. There are 800 Veterans in Oscoda County and only 100 seek assistance through the county. If you know of a veteran in need, feel free to direct them to the Veterans Affairs Office in Mio.

New Business:

Motion to approve the final 2025/2026 budget was made by Lake, second by Bissonette. All in favor.

Motion to approve the final 2026/2027 budget was made by Bissonette, second by Lake. All in favor.

A copy of the approved budget is available at your township hall.

The budget included no raises for elected officials.

At the request of the clerk that election workers receive higher pay, Bissonette motioned to raise pay for election workers, with the chair being paid \$325 and the workers being paid \$275 for the day. Lindsey seconded the motion. All in favor.

The fire chief presented estimates for new SCBA equipment in the amount of \$5000.00. Motion to approve the purchase by Bissonette, with a second by Lake. All in favor.

The fire chief presented an estimate for new vinyl lettering for four fire department vehicles, to make them all uniform, in the amount of \$2,425.00. Bissonette motioned to approve the purchase, second by Lake. All in favor.

Free dump day this year will be Saturday June 27th, from 9am to 2pm.

No public comment.

No remarks from the board.

Motion by Lake to adjourn at 6:25pm.

The next board meeting will be April 14, 2026 at 6:00pm.
